## Using the Gender Evaluation Criteria in Design Phase

### Example of use in design phase (land regularization):

- 2010 announcement that residents in Ponto do Maduro will not be evicted
- Local Committee in Recife, Brazil (federal agency owning the land, state agency undertaking regularizations, FUNDAJ (research) and Espaço Feminista)
- Social survey based on the criteria also as a baseline to later assess impact



## Using the Gender Evaluation Criteria in Design Phase

Using the Gender Evaluation Criteria (GEC) in the design of new projects/programmes/initiatives:

- The GEC can also be a useful instrument at start of a land process:
  - In the design phase—to make sure it meets demands of both women and men
  - Making sure gender aspects explicitly integrated
- Rephrase the 22 evaluation criteria so as not to ask 'is' or 'did' but 'will' it'
