The Arab Land Initiative's Network


- A network of land governance champions (2200+ experts & practitioners)



Objective: advance good land governance in the Arab region, through increased leadership from regional – national – local champions






































Arab Land Conference's attendance & ownership


Arab Land Initiative - Way forward / Themes
