



Overview of the work – UN-Habitat




UN-Habitat well positioned across the humanitarian-developmentpeace nexus, including on land in fragile contexts


- 1. Protection of Housing, Land and Property Rights of displaced people, refugees, returnees including mapping, recordation, and registration (also in support of restitution)
- 2. Emergency / transitional shelters and settlements (incl. planning)
- 3. Housing rehabilitation, including HLP due diligence
- 4. Profiling, including HLP
- 5. Country level coordination –HLP/protection & Shelter Cluster and other coordination mechanisms
- Land strategies for conflict-affected countries (e.g. Syria HLP framework, adaptation of the UN SG Guidance Note on Land & Conflict, etc.)

- Support to UN-Habitat work at regional and country level (incl. portfolio development, capacity development, technical advisory)
- Normative guidance: UN SG Guidance

 Root cause analysis on land and conflict




